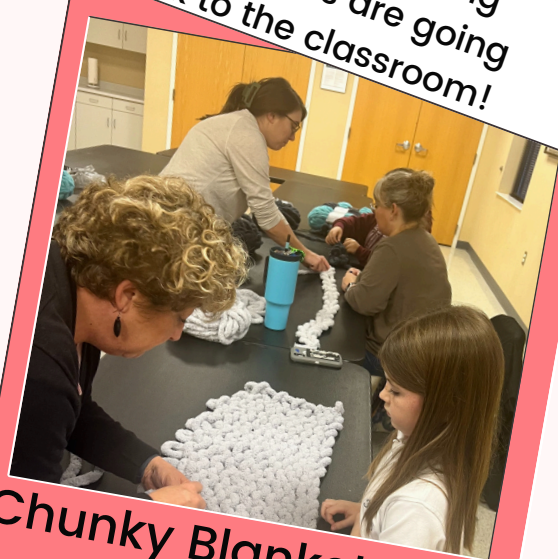

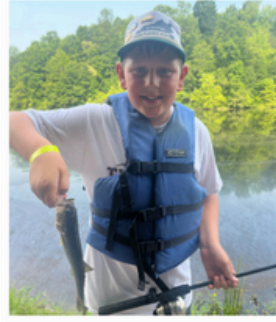

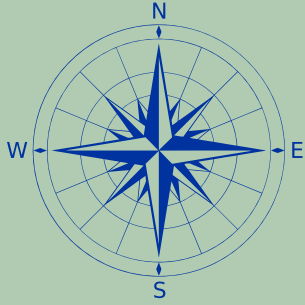

BBQ VENISON MEATBALLS

Ingredients:

Meatballs

- 1 pound ground venison (may substitute elk or beef)
- ½ cup 2% milk
- ¾ cup rolled oats
- ½ cup minced fresh onion
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon black pepper

Sauce

- *1 cup ketchup
- *½ cup water
- *½ cup grated onion
- *2 tablespoons vinegar
- *¼ cup brown sugar
- *¼ teaspoon black pepper



Directions:

1. Combine venison, milk, oats, onion, salt, and pepper in a large bowl.
2. Use a sturdy spoon or clean hands to mix well. Shape meat mixture into 12 1-inch balls, and place in a shallow 9-by-13-inch baking pan.
3. *Combine all the sauce ingredients in a bowl and stir well. Pour sauce over meatballs.
4. Bake uncovered at 350 degrees F for 1 hour, turning over twice.
