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








# Henderson County 4-H Babysitting Clinic



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## Frozen Fruit Cups

Servings: 18 Serving Size: 1 muffin cup







## Ingredients:

- 1 (3 ounce) package lemon gelatin
- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 (20 ounce) can unsweetened pineapple tidbits, undrained
- 1 (10.5 ounce) can mandarin oranges, drained
- 1 (6 ounce can) frozen orange juice concentrate, partially thawed
- 1 large, firm banana, sliced

#### Directions:

- 1. In a large bowl, dissolve gelatin in boiling water; cool for 10 minutes. Stir in the remaining ingredients.
- Spoon into foil cups. Freeze until firm.
- Remove from freezer 30 minutes before serving.
