BAKED FRUIT

Ingredients:

- 4 cups of fresh or canned fruit (drain if using canned)
- 1 tablespoon margarine
- ¼ cup brown sugar, packed
- 1 tablespoon cinnamon



Directions:

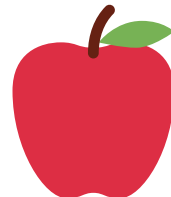
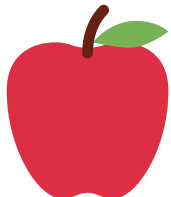
1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F.
2. Arrange fruit in a flat baking dish.
3. Dot top of fruit with margarine.
4. Combine brown sugar and cinnamon; sprinkle over fruit.
5. Bake 30 minutes.
